## Message from the Pastor's Desk

In my daily Bible reading I have been studying the life of David in I and II Samuel. As always this has been an interesting read.

David's father sent him to check on his brothers who were in battle with King Saul against the Philistines. David found his brothers, King Saul and all of Israel's army frozen in fear of Goliath. They were unable to fight the giant because of fear.

Sometimes fear can be defined as  $\underline{\mathbf{F}}$  also  $\underline{\mathbf{E}}$  xaggerations  $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$  ssumed  $\underline{\mathbf{R}}$  eal. They certainty assumed wrong in thinking Goliath could not be beaten. For, with the help of God, David defeated Goliath that day!

Some of you may not see our printed financial report or hear the report during our quarterly business meetings so here is a recap of where we are year-to-date. As of June 30, 2018 we have received 85% of the 6 months budget requirement and have spent 98%. This means that we are spending more than we are receiving in contributions. Please be prayerful about what you can do to improve this. Any time we don't have Sunday School or have to cancel an entire day of services, we fall behind in contributions received.

As a word of praise, since our first principal payment on the FLC loan in July, 2015, we have reduced the loan by \$351,000. About \$100,000 of this was made possible by an adjustment in interest received on investments. This is still an ongoing project that we need to be much in prayer about.
