Message from the Pastor's Desk

We will have inside worship Sunday, February 7, 2021 at 10 AM.

We are making it through the days of covid-19. But I wonder, what is it doing to us. We need to be aware of how our lives have changed in the past 10 months. And we need to understand that some of the changes are not so good.

For one thing, so much of our church life has been placed on TV. We watch worship on TV, tablets, and cell phones. We watch Sunday School and Bible study the same way. But therein is a problem. If we are not careful, we will find ourselves turning it off in mid-broadcast and making a vow with ourselves that we will "watch it later." And to compound the problem, we stop studying our Bibles.

This is where Right Now Media (RNM) comes into focus... RNM is based out of Texas. RNM provides videos for Discipleship growth as well as Bible study. You can google their Web page or find them on YouTube and other media.

Recently our Church Council and I decided to join RNM. On Sunday, February 14th we will launch this ministry. You will receive an email from me inviting you to take advantage of this ministry. And the good news is that it is absolutely free! Our church is paying only \$79.00 per month to provide every person in our church who has an email address the opportunity to enjoy these videos.
